Introduction

- Development and growth of the Internet and ICTs in Africa
 - capacity to sustain the growth
 - specialized technical and R&D capacity
- Emergence of Research and Education Networks (RENS)
 - cornerstone for facilitating future developments







Overview of NEPAD

- a long-term vision of African-owned and African-led development
- Infrastructure sector: expanded cross-border development of infrastructure;adequate knowledge and skills
- ICT sector: development of research capacity
- Education sector: promote networks of specialised research and higher education institutions.

Overview of NEPAD

- NEPAD Planning and Coordinating Agency
 - technical agency of the African
 - Mandate: to facilitate and coordinate continental and regional priority programmes; to conduct and coordinate research and knowledge management;
- NEPAD e-Africa Programme
 - develops policies, strategies; develops broad strategies for ICT infrastructure and the use of ICT applications and services on the continent





NEPAD Centers of Excellence

- overall goal is to increase the socioeconomic benefits afforded by the Internet and ICTs in Africa
 - foster regional and continental collaboration
 - develop high-level capacity and expertise
 - establish African resource centers and knowledge repositories
 - increase the use and generation of scientific knowledge

Collaborative Framework

- model that brings together academia, private sector, government and civil society as stakeholders
 - informed by and informing policy
 - address public and private sector needs for research and innovation
 - contribute to the body of knowledge
 - inform African programming and spending on ICT projects and interventions.

Role of NEPAD

- development of an enabling environment that allows RENs and hence the Centers of Excellence to flourish.
 - regulatory and policy environment for crossborder networks
 - policies for education, research and ICT
 - advocating for public funding for research initiatives
 - promotion of public-private partnerships
 - linkages with community informatics network

Role of RENs

- High quality broadband connectivity
 - enable collaboration, access to and sharing of information.
- Establishment of test-bed environments for R&D
- Data and statistics for academic research and evidence-based policy making



Conclusion

- Collaboration between NEPAD and RENs is a win-win proposition that will enhance ICT development in Africa.
- RENs provide the physical networks while Centers of Excellence provide the human and institutional networks.
