

## **UBUNTUNET ALLIANCE TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **Ubuntunet Alliance for Research and Education Networking terms and conditions**

UbuntuNet Alliance aims to provide cost-effective network service to its members through the establishment of dedicated network links that are functionally separated from the commercial Internet services. The Alliance undertakes to operate these (directly or through other parties) links on a non-profit basis and therefore it follows that they cannot be used to carry or channel commercial traffic, except in interfacing their primary users to commercial service providers. The following terms and conditions apply to all services to the extent relevant:

1. UbuntuNet Alliance is committed to ensuring that the use of its network is lawful and all customers agree and undertake to respect the law in using our services.
2. Customers are prohibited from using any of our services in order to create, store or disseminate any illegal content.
3. Customers in particular undertake and agree that they will respect copyright and intellectual property law and not utilise our services to access and/or download content to which they are not lawfully entitled.
4. When utilising our Internet access services customers undertake and agree that they will not send or promote the sending of unsolicited communications or spam.
